Science

We will be focusing on understanding animals including humans by answering the question, 'Do all living things start life as an egg?' We will also be working scientifically by carrying out investigations.

History:

In history we will be exploring the question, 'What happened to Britain when the Romans left?' We will be discussing the changes in Britain between 410AD and 1066AD and learning about the various groups who invaded Britain during that time; including the Vikings and the Anglo Saxons.

Maths

This half term we will be deepening our understanding of place value by building on our existing knowledge of numbers.

We will then practise using our four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and develop our reasoning and problem solving skills. We will also have a strong focus on learning and using mathematically vocabulary.
