

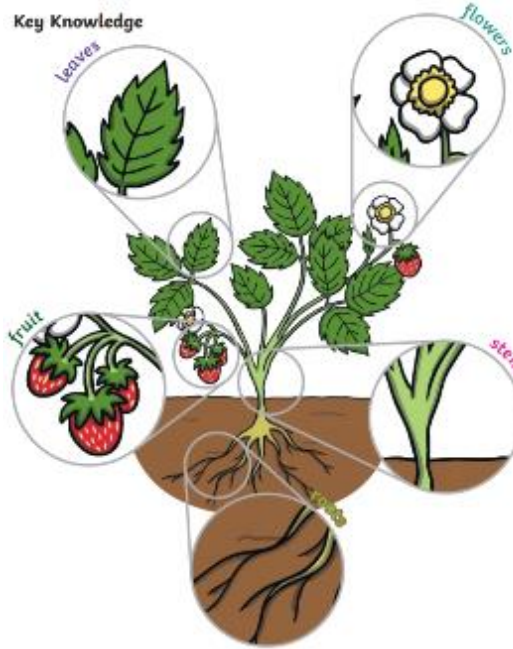

Wild plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It does not need to be planted or cared for as it grows.
Leaf	The part of the plant that creates food.
Deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
Flower	The part of the plant that is bright and colourful to attract insects.
Habitat	The environment in which an animal lives.
Evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.
