

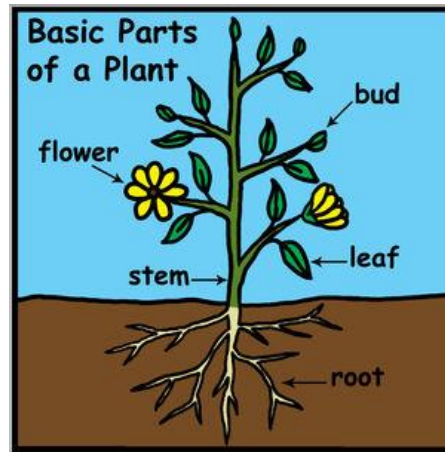
# Knowledge Organiser - Year 2/3 - Autumn 1



## Key Knowledge

1.	Plants have four key parts, the flower, roots, stem and roots.
2.	Each part of a plant has a different function that helps the plant to stay alive and grow.
3.	Plants need sunlight, water, warmth, air and nutrients to grow and survive.
4.	Plants transport water from the roots to the stem, leaves and flowers through a process called transpiration.
5.	Plants have a life cycle that involves, pollination, seed dispersal and formation.

## Vocabulary

Root	The part of the plant that grows into the ground and takes up nutrients.
Leaf	The part of the plant that creates food.
Stem	The part of the plant that keeps it upright.
Flower	The part of the plant that is bright and colourful to attract insects.
Life cycle	the series of changes in the life of an organism including reproduction.
Transport	To move something from one place to another.
Anchor	To secure firmly in place.
