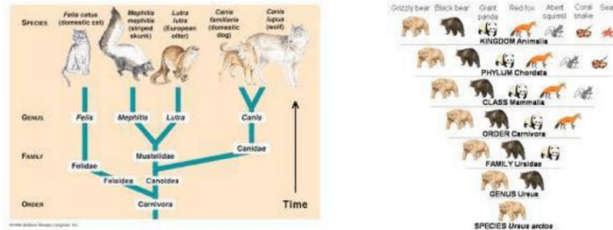


Key Knowledge	
1.	The 7 characteristics of living things are: movement, respiration, sensitivity, growth, reproduction, excretion and nutrition
2.	Vertebrates have a backbone - mammals, fish and birds. Invertebrates do not have a backbone - insects etc.
3.	Animalia is the animal kingdom. Plantae is the plant kingdom
4.	Mammals are warm blooded, breathe air and give birth to live young.
5.	Fish are vertebrates, gill-bearings, aquatic and mostly cold-blooded.
6.	Reptiles are vertebrates, cold-blooded, lay eggs and have scaled or hard parts.

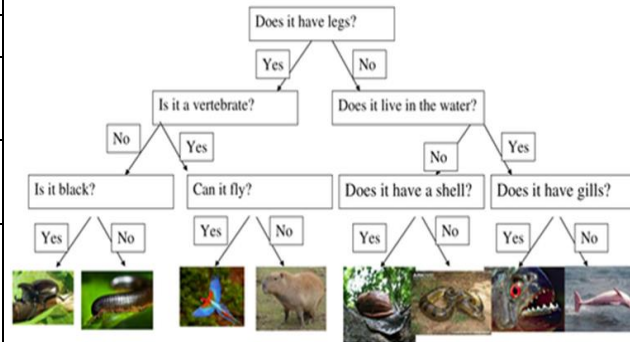
Trafford Facts

Invertebrate	An animal without a backbone
Vertebrate	An animal with a backbone
Mammal	A warm-blooded vertebrate animal that has hair or fur
Amphibian	A cold-blooded vertebrate animal
Habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant or other organism
Micro organism	A microscopic organism including bacteria, virus or fungi
Arachnid	A group of small animals, similar to insects, with four pairs of legs, for example a spider
