Dear parents and carers,

With the safety of your children, our staff and families and the wider community, a very difficult decision has been made to partially open the school from tomorrow, Tuesday 5th January 2021.

This will mean only children of key working families, **whereby both parents/carers are key workers or a single parent/carer family is a key worker**, vulnerable families and children who have an EHCP, may continue to access school at this time.

We have made contact this morning with those who were on that list during the first lockdown. However, if you have not been contacted and you feel that your child may be eligible for a place because you are now a Key Worker, email us as a matter of urgency to confirm your profession so that we can gather the required information to support decision-making and confirm details to families of children who will be returning to school.

Please note that those invited to attend will be strictly limited to those children identified by school as being vulnerable, those who have **two** parents whose role is essential to the COVID response or who are parenting alone with a key role.

The purpose is to keep the numbers as low as possible, to limit transmission to our community and to enable the teachers to focus on the online learning of all children.

Key worker children will only be invited to attend school on days when both parents are working. Parents working from home should not send children into school.

During the course of the day we will write to you to confirm the arrangements being put in place for families with children not returning to school. Information will include the ways in which school has been preparing for remote learning.
