Science

We will be focusing on the topic of Everyday Materials.

We will be looking at the uses and suitability of materials for different purposes and focus on how to recycle.

Maths

In Maths we will focus on developing our knowledge of Statistics, looking at bar charts, pictograms and tables.

We will then move on to a recap of Length and Perimeter to refresh our knowledge of measurement.

Then we will begin a topic about Fractions. We will calculate fractions of amounts and find equivalent fractions.

DT:

We will be focusing on Food Technology. We will look at healthy eating and design and make our own healthy pizzas.

History:

In History we will be beginning a topic about the Stone Age to Iron Age. This topic will continue for the whole of the Summer term. We will look back at how Stone Age civilisations lived and survived, making tools and hunting and gathering food. We will then move through time to the Bronze Age and compare how the times change from the Stone Age, before finally moving onto looking at the Iron Age Period and seeing where the skills and knowledge has developed over time.

PSHE:

We will be discussing the question 'What is a community?'

COMPUTING:

We will be taking part in iCreate with Junior Jam and sessions focusing on e-safety and staying safe online.

RE:

Year 3 will discuss the question: Why are festivals important to Hindus?

PE:

PE will take place on a **Wednesday** and **Friday**. On Wednesday we will take part in a gymnastics session and a Junior Jam PE session on Friday. Children must come into school in uniform on both days and change in school.
