Maths

In Maths we will focus on developing our knowledge of algebra, ratio and statistics.

We will also focus on different types of angles and 2D and 3D shapes. We will continue to recap prior learning in our daily 10 sessions.

We will apply all of this knowledge when answering both arithmetic and reasoning style questions.

Science

We will be focusing on the topic of evolution and inheritance.

We will be researching and answering the question 'how have animals adapted to survive?'

COMPUTING:

We will be taking part in iCreate with Junior Jam and sessions focusing on e-safety and staying safe online.

DT:

We will be focusing on textiles as we will create Binca bookmarks using a needle and thread developing our sewing skills.

History:

In History we will be focusing on themes in British History focusing on crime and punishment. We will be researching and answering the question 'how has crime and punishment changes over the last 500 years.' We will focus on what crime and punishment looked like during the different periods of History including: Anglo-Saxons, Romans, the Tudors, Victorians and crime in 2021.

PSHE:

We will be discussing the question 'what will change as we become independent?'

RE:

Year 6 will discuss the question: what we can we learn from religions about deciding between right and wrong?

Homework:

Homework is set on Google Classroom every **FRIDAY** and must be 'handed in' by the following **WEDNESDAY**. Spellings will be taught daily during our in class spelling sessions. Focus words will be posted onto Class Dojo at the start of each new topic.

Music:

Our Junior Jam sessions will focus on iJam: Singing and Song Writing.

PE:

PE will take place on a **Wednesday** and **Friday**. On Wednesday we will take part in a gymnastics session and a Junior Jam cricket session on Friday. Children can come into school in their PE kits on these days.
