Science

We will be focusing on understanding all about plants and answering the question 'What birds, plants and animals can we find in our Wild Woods?'. We will be learning what plants need to grow and how they change throughout the year.

Maths

In Maths we will be strengthening our knowledge of place value within 10. This will include sorting, comparing and ordering numbers with 10.

We will then start to explore addition and subtraction within 10.

COMPUTING:

We will be starting with the topic of E-Safety and will be looking at how we can stay safe online.

History:

In History we will be discussing the question 'What toys did my Grandparents play with?' as part of our Changes within Living Memory topic. We will be comparing how toys have changed since our grandparents were little, and how some toys are still around today. We will also be learning about where our grandparents bought toys from and how this has changed throughout history.

PSHE:

We will be focussing on the question 'What is the same and different about us?'

We will be exploring what makes us who we are and how we are all unique in our own ways.

RE:

Year 1 will discuss various questions including: Who is a Christian and what do they believe?

Music:

We will be looking at Hip-Hop music. We will be learning about pulse, rhythm and pitch.

PE:

PE will take place every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon.

Full PE kits must be worn and left in school.

Homework:
