

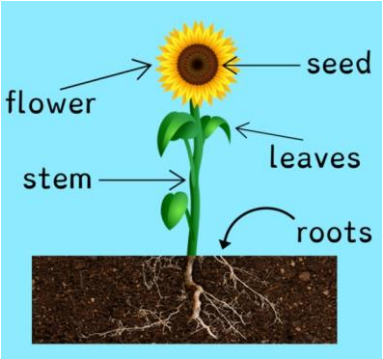

branches	The woody part of a tree or bush that grows out from the trunk.
bulb	A plant bud that begins to grow underground.
seed	The unit of reproduction for a flowering plant, which grows into another plant.
