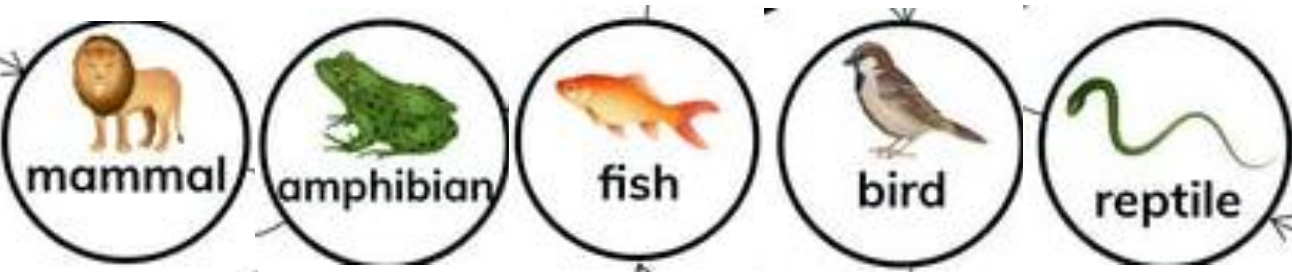
Vocabulary
