Science

Phonics:

We will be continuing with our phonics scheme. We are learning about special friends, which is when 2 letters are put together to make one sound.

RE:

We will be diving into Christianity, who Jesus is and what some Christians believe Jesus did.

PE:

PE will take place every Tuesday afternoon. This term, we will be learning about invasion games. We will be building our skills in order to take part in games such as football and basketball. We will also be developing our team work and communication skills.

History:

In History, we will be exploring how communication has changed over the years. We will be learning about what communication is and why it is important in our daily lives. We will take a look at how people would communicate in the past and how it had adapted. We will finish by writing our very own letter to Father Christmas.

Please remember to read with your child every night. Each child will have a phonics book, a picture book and a reading record book. The reading record book can be signed by parent, carers, older siblings and pupils.
