Seasons	There are different weathers in each season. These are autumn, winter, spring and summer. As the seasons change, so does the weather. Humans and animals adapt to these changes. In each season there are different months.
Autumn	In Autumn, the weather gets colder. The days are shorter and night are longer. The trees begin to fall from the trees we harvest crops.
Winter	In winter, animals go into hibernation. The weather is colder, often freezing. We might see snow during this time. The days are even shorter and the nights are even longer.
Spring	In spring, flowers begin to grow. The trees have leaves and some have blossoms. The days begin to get longer and the nights begin to get shorter.
Summer	In summer, the weather is hotter. The days are the longest and the nights are the shortest. The trees have leaves and flowers are blossomed.
